~ PELHAM MEMORIAL SCHOOL NEWS ~

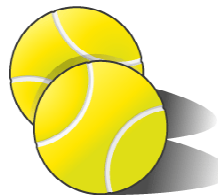
Pelham Memorial had a very successful opening, and the students are adjusting nicely.
